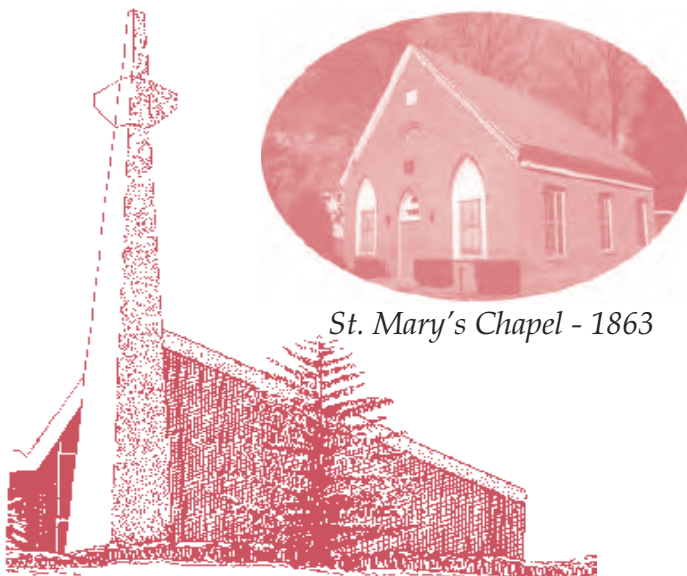

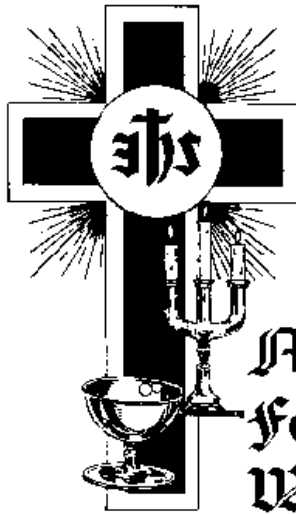
"Watson, look up and tell me what you see," Holmes said.

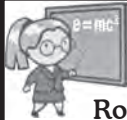
