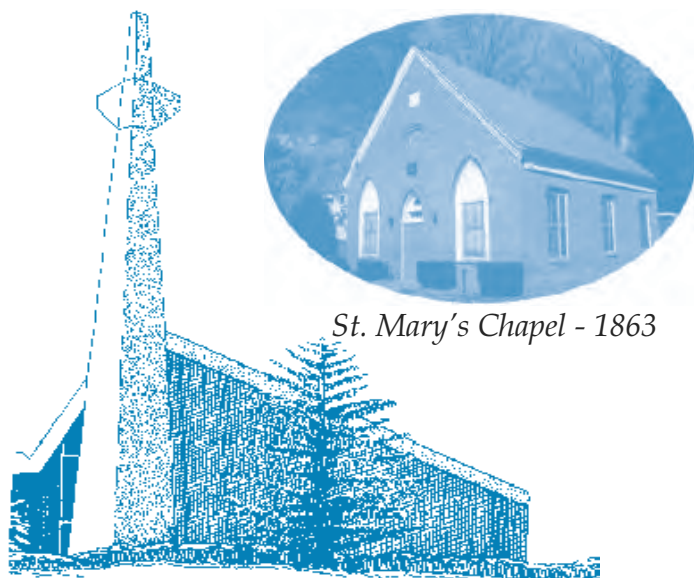

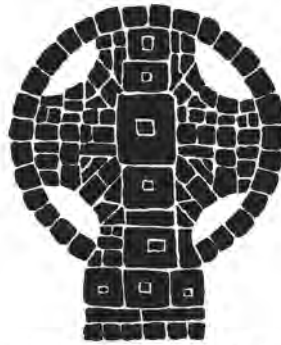

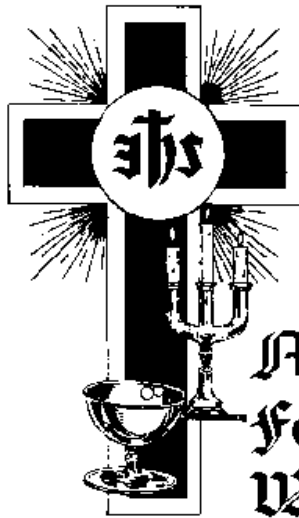

Even though they are the ones who deserve compassion, they develop the rare ability to offer compassion to friends and loved ones. Every choice they make is made with great care, from what you will have for dinner to what book you will read. Joy, peace, reconciliation and serenity become the driving forces in their life.

Once they realize that their exit from life's stage has been scripted, once they accept the reality that "later" is "now" and "tomorrow" is "today," every experience is cherished, every moment is lived with joyful gratitude. (thoughts from Morris West and others.)

Jesus calls us to realize what many of the terminally ill understand: that this life of ours is precious, that our time is limited. He calls us to "get serious" and not sleep through the opportunities life gives us to discover God in the love of others; to pay attention to the signs of God's presence in our lives, to live life expectantly, as a gift.
