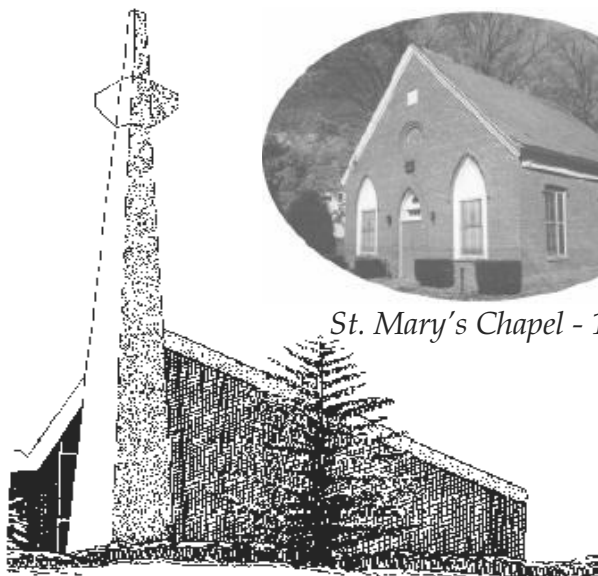

## ***BE ALL THAT YOU CAN BE! EVEN THE SMALLEST GOOD DEEDS COUNT!***

A cashier at a local hardware store is nearing the end of her shift. The store's air conditioning isn't working, several sale items aren't priced correctly, her last customer shouted at her and stormed out of the store because it took so long to ring up his order, and on top of that, her feet are tired and aching. She finishes ringing up her current customer's order, who turns to her before leaving, gives her a warm smile, and says, "Thanks, Kate, you have a nice day."

This unexpected gesture is a cool breeze that makes her forget about the heat, the tantrums and her tired feet. She smiles and thanks her customer for his patience.

Suddenly his long wait in line seems trivial compared to what this woman has been dealing with all day. He, in turn, drives away from the store feeling more patient and upbeat himself. He spots an elderly woman approaching an upcoming crosswalk. He stops and motions her to cross with a wave of his hand and a smile.

The woman is grateful to the driver for being patient enough to let her cross the street. As she continues on her way, she smiles at a young girl sitting alone on a porch.

The little girl, happy to be noticed, waves back and suddenly notices the little boy next door, whom she invites over to play Frisbee.

The boy is delighted to finally have someone to play with. He has been moping around his yard all afternoon because his older brother is off with his own friends, not wanting to be "stuck" with his kid brother.

As the children play, the Frisbee flies into the yard of the new family on the block. When he retrieves the toy, the boy invites the new kid on the street to come and play too.

This warms the heart of the new kid's mother. She hugs her husband and tells him that she thinks their son will make lots of new friends here.

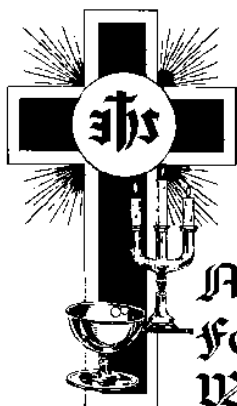

***Lenten Fast and Abstinence*** - During the season of Lent, the Church urges the faithful to reflect a spirit of penance in their daily lives through performing acts of faith and abstinence.

***FASTING*** requires that only one full meal be taken per day. Two other smaller meals may be taken during the day to maintain physical strength, but these two meals together should not equal a full meal in quantity. Nor is there eating between meals. Fasting obliges all those who have reached the age of 18 and continues to oblige through age 59. Those who are not specifically obliged to fast are encouraged to join in the discipline of fasting to the extent that they are able.

***ABSTINENCE*** prohibits individuals from eating meat on a particular day. Abstinence obliges all those who have reached the age of 14 and continues to oblige throughout their lives. Those who are not specifically obliged to abstain from eating meat are encouraged to join in the discipline of abstaining to the extent that they are able.

**Ash Wednesday** and **Good Friday** are days of **Fast and Abstinence**. **Fridays in Lent** are days of **Abstinence**.

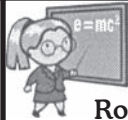

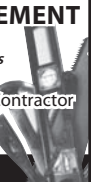
